XI. International Ceramics Symposium Römhild, Thuringia, Germany From 5 August until 2 September 2018.

The XI. International Ceramics Symposium in the town of Römhild in 2018 will focus on the theme of "Ceramics Speak Many Languages".

Conditions of participation:

The number of participants is limited to a maximum of eight artists who are chosen from the applicants by a panel of experts.

Each participating artist will receive a grant amounting to €2,000.00, as well as free food and accommodation, for the duration of the symposium.

We expressly require experimental work for creating expanded forms of expression, particularly in the sphere of **sculptures**.

We will provide: **clay and porcelain** for a very wide variety of different production technologies and firing temperatures, as well as **state of the art firing technology from the firm ROHDE**, electric and gas-fired chamber kilns and top loaders, wood-fired open-fire kilns, top-hat kilns, trolley hearth kilns and RAKU kilns. Temporary firing technologies can also be made available operationally, depending on demand and firing requirements.

Artists are traditionally given a certificate of participation at the end of the symposium ends.

All artistic works are publicised in exhibitions and in an exhibition catalogue. Selected works will be shown in a permanent exhibition at **Schloss Glücksburg CERAMICS MUSEUM**.
